

SPY CAMERA PEN

Model: 1080PEN

Quick Start Guide

1. Before first use, charge the pen using the supplied USB cable. Twist open the pen at the middle to expose the charging point. When the pen is charging the orange light will illuminate.
2. The mode switch (above the USB charging point) can be used to select still photograph or videos. Mode 1 will take still photographs, Mode 2 will take videos.
3. Insert the memory card into the memory card slot above the USB connector; make sure to firmly seat the memory card in place. The back edge of the memory card should be almost level with the gold part of the pen. Screw the two halves back together.
4. To turn on the camera press and hold the button on the top of the pen. The indicator light will flash blue before going out. In mode 1, the audio automatically starts recording, to take a still image, click the top button. This will stop the audio recording, click the button again to start the audio recording. In mode 2, the camera will start recording automatically.
5. To stop the recording, click the top button. The orange light will illuminate to indicate that the file is being saved. To start another recording, simply click the top button once more.
6. To turn off, press and hold the top button until indicator light goes off.

The camera will automatically loop recordings if left to run or until the battery runs out. Recordings will be saved in 15minute file lengths.
