



# How to use

## Inserting the battery pack




1 Open the cover.


2 Insert the battery pack.

## Charging the battery pack

Turn off the camera while charging the battery.

# Charging time (Full charge)

The charging time is approximately 115 min. using the AC Adaptor (supplied).

The battery pack can be charged by connecting the camera to a computer using a micro USB cable







# Shooting still images/movies





### On camera's temperature


