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IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

WARNING:

- It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to electrical parts.
- This product is intended for household use only. Do not use outdoors.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children less than 8 years.
- Only use the charger provided with the product. Using another charger may damage the product and battery.
- Do not immerse in water or other liquids for cleaning.
- Do not store or charge the unit outdoors
- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces

- Keep hair, clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body clear of moving parts.
- Do not pick up anything that is flammable, burning or smoking.
- Use extra care when cleaning on the stairs.
- Never remove parts from the appliance such as the feet, screws and so on.
- Only use the accessories supplied by the manufacturer.


WARNING:

- Do not use the charger if power cord or plug has been damaged.
- Do not use cordless vacuum cleaner or charger if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped in water. Contact customer services for advice.
- Do not run over charger cord with vacuum cleaner.
 Always unplug charger from vacuum cleaner before use.
- Never carry the charger by the cord, or yank to disconnect from an outlet, to unplug, always grasp the plug to remove from outlet, do not pull on cord.
- Keep charger cord away from heated surfaces(e.g., cooking surfaces).
- Do not handle charger cord or vacuum cleaner with wet hands or while barefoot.
- Do not put any objects into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked, keep free of dust, lint, hair and anything that may reduce particle flow into the dust container.
- Do not use the vacuum cleaner without dust container in place.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

- Do not attempt to empty dust container while unit is running, always turn off the appliance and unplug before emptying/replacing the dust container.
- Turn off vacuum cleaner before clearing debris from floor brush assembly
- Do not run the vacuum cleaner over any cables, as this will result in damaging the cable.

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TURBO LITE ULTRA ASSEMBLY

Before using your cleaner

Remove all packaging and lay out the separate components.

Check the unit after unpacking for any visual damage such as:

- Misaligned or damaged parts
- Damage to the main body and separate components
- Damage to the plug or cable.

If you can see any damage do not use the cleaner and contact customer services.

Charge your Turbo Lite Ultra before first use.




TURBO LITE ULTRA ASSEMBLY

Attaching the Powered Floor Head

and pull away the extension tube.

The powered floor head can be used with or without the extension tube.


1. To use without the extension tube, line up the pins and push the floor head directly onto the nozzle of the handheld unit until it clicks.



2. To use the floor head with the extension tube, place the extension tube onto the nozzle of the handheld unit, ensuring that the pins are aligned and click in to place.

Then, push the floor head onto the end of the extension tube, ensuring the pins are aligned.

Note: You do not need to use the connecting joint when attaching the floor head.

CHARGING YOUR TURBO LITE ULTRA

Before using for the first time you will need to charge the cleaner.

1. Before charging ensure the cleaner is switched off.

2. Plug the charging cable into the adaptor socket on the side of the handheld unit. Insert the plug into a suitable 13 Amp mains socket, pressing the switch on.

3. Lift the assembled cleaner onto the charger dock, ensuring that the

The charging indicator light on the handheld vacuum will illuminate red, flashing in 2 second intervals to show that the unit is charging.

A full first time charge should be given, of 5 hours.

Once charged, the indicator light will illuminate solid red.

Note:

- The body may become warm during charging and this is completely normal.
- Make sure the battery is charged when the product will not be used for prolonged periods of time.
- This vacuum cleaner is not designed to be left standing upright as this can cause the vacuum cleaner to fall over, causing damage to the vacuum cleaner.

USING YOUR TURBO LITE ULTRA

Once assembled and charged:

1. Unplug the charger and place the floor head on the floor.

2. Slide the power switch on the top of the unit to start the power.

3. Move the cleaner floor head in a forwards and backwards motion over the areas you would like to clean.

Note: Large items can get trapped in the brush/floor head which could cause the unit to overheat. Make sure you pick up larger items that could get trapped before vacuuming.

4. To turn off the power, slide the power switch on the top of the unit.



<u>USING YOUR TURBO LITE ULTRA – 2 IN 1</u> <u>BRUSH AND CREVICE TOOL</u>


Attaching the tools

<u>Brush Tool</u>

Is it important to align the connecting joint and handheld unit, as misalignment may cause damage.

The brush tool can be used for dusting and cleaning delicate surfaces. To use the brush tool, first attach the connecting joint to the handheld unit. Then, push the 2 in 1 attachment into the connecting joint.

Slide the brush to the end of the tool until it clicks into place.




Crevice Tool

The crevice tool is for narrow gaps and hard to reach places.

To use the crevice tool, push the 2 in 1 attachment into the nozzle (as above).


Push the button on the end of the brush tool (1) and slide the brush back to expose the crevice tool until the brush clicks in to place.



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
USING YOUR TURBO LITE ULTRA

Make sure to empty the dust container before the 'MAX' fill line is reached. Press the release button on the top of the vacuum cleaner (1), and lift the dust container clear of the base.



Whilst holding over a bin or inside a bin bag, press down the button on the dust container below the nozzle to open the bottom and release the dust (2).

Important: You may wish to empty the dust container outdoors as emptying may create a dust cloud.



Once empty, close the bottom of the dust container then clip the dust container back into the vacuum cleaner unit, ensuring the bottom of the dust container is correctly located before the release button clicks back into place.

CLEANING AND CARE: CLEANING THE FILTER

Turn off and unplug the cleaner. Remove the dust container as per instructions on page 13.

(2) Remove the filter assembly by unclipping the filter release clips on both sides of the dust (3) container. (1) (1) Twist the lid of the dust container assembly to the UNLOCK position and remove (2). Remove the sponge and HEPA filters (3). To clean, remove excess dust from the filter using a soft brush. Wash in warm water and allow to dry for 24 hours.

Replace the filters, then twist the lid of the dust container to the LOCK position. Refit the dust container as per the instructions on page 13.

<u>CLEANING AND CARE:</u> <u>CLEANING THE FLOOR HEAD</u>

Remove the brush head from the unit.

Using a flat head screwdriver or a small coin, rotate the lock on the brush cover in an anti-clockwise direction (1)


Remove the brush cover and place to one side.

Slip the belt over the brush bar, remove the brush bar and pull away any tangled hair or debris.

Check that there are no blockages in the brush head.

Replace the brush bar, ensuring that the belt is correctly positioned over the teeth on the brush bar. Reinsert the brush cover and click in to place.

Rotate the lock in a clockwise direction and check that it is secured in to place (2)



CLEANING AND CARE

Before you clean the appliance, make sure the power is switched off and that the unit is not on the charging stand.

To clean the exterior of the device, use a damp, soft cloth and mild detergent.

NEVER IMMERSE THE CLEANER IN WATER.

Wash non-electrical removable accessories in warm soapy water and allow to dry thoroughly before next use.

PROBLEM SOLVING

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE PROBLEM	POSSIBLE SOLUTION
	The cleaner hasn't had enough charge	Make sure you have plugged in the cleaner to charge for 5 hours. The light will flash when charging.
The cleaner won't turn on	Charging cable is damaged	Make sure there is no signs of damage to the charging cable. If there is damage, do not use. Contact Customer Services.
	The power button has not been pressed	Make sure you have turned on the power using the switch on the main unit.
The suction is decreasing and the cleaner is not picking up dirt	Dust container	Check if the dust container is full, if so, empty it.
	Filters are dirty	Clean the filters. After around 6 months of regular use the filters may need replacing. Contact Customer Services using the details at the bottom of this page.
	Handheld/head blockages	Check that there are no blockages in the handheld suction inlet or floor head or tubes. If so, clear these blockages.
Cleaner is over heating	Filters are dirty	Check that the filters are not blocked, if so, clean them following the instructions in this booklet.
Dust is coming out of the vacuum cleaner	Dust container fitting	The dust container has not been fitted correctly. Refit the container following the instructions in this booklet.
The air coming out og the vacuum cleaner smells	Filters are dirty	Clean the filters and dust container.
	Filters are not dry	Ensure the filters have been left to dry for 24 hours before refitting back into the vacuum cleaner and using.
Battery is running out faster than standard run time	The battery is worn	Replace Battery. Contact Customer Services using the details at the bottom of this page.


