



Care Instructions





Ensuring the underside of the sink is clean and dry, apply the foam sealing tape around the underside of the sink edge, ensuring it is smooth and without creases or ridges.



The supplied fixing clips are designed for 35-45mm thick counter tops. If your counter top is thinner, use wood spacers to secure the clips.

After placing two fixing clips at each corner of the sink, space any remaining clips around the perimeter of the sink.



Tighten the fixing clips screws with a hand screwdriver to ensure the sink is secure. Do not overtighten as this may result in damage.
