

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SAFETY INFORMATION

- Read these instructions All the safety and operating instructions should be read before this product is operated.
- Keep these instructions The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
- Heed all warnings All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
- Follow all instructions All operating and usage instructions should be followed.
- Do not use this equipment near water The appliance should not be used near water or moisture e.g. in a wet basement or near a swimming pool.
- Clean only with a dry cloth. Do not use solvents or petroleum-based fluids.
- Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, stoves or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- Do not tamper with the supplied plug. This plug is a BS1363 standard plug.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched, particularly at the plug and at the point where they exit from the appliance.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Unplug the apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- Refer all servicing to qualified personnel. Servicing is required when the
 apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as power supply cord or plug

- The TV should only be connected to a mains power supply with AC 100-240V~ 50/60Hz
- To prevent overload, do not share the same power supply socket with too many other electronic components.

- Do not place heavy items on the cable as this may cause damage.
- Hold the main plug, not the wires, when removing from a socket.
- Unplug immediately and seek professional help if the plug or cable is damaged, liquid has spilt onto the set, if accidentally exposed to water or moisture, if anything accidentally penetrates the ventilation slots or if the set does not work normally.
- Do not remove the safety covers. There are no user serviceable parts inside.
- To avoid battery leakage, remove exhausted batteries from the remote control when not in use for a long period.
- Do not block ventilation slots on the back cover. The TV can be placed in a

cabinet but ensure the guidance on clearances are followed.

- Do not tap or shake the TV screen, this may damage internal components.
- Diagrams within the manual are for illustrative purposes only, and as such there may be differences to the actual product received.





ATTENTION









When twisting the TV set, do not hold the top of the TV, you should twist from the base.

• When lifting the TV, do not use one hand to handle it, you should lift the TV using two hands, ensuring pressure is not put on the screen







CONNECTION AND PREPARATION OF THE TV



INSTALLATION OF LEGS

- 1 Place the TV with the front facing downwards on a soft cloth pads on a desk.
- 2 Insert the legs into the sockets on the base of the TV.
- 3 Insert the screws into the sockets and tighten them with a screwdriver. Do not use an electric screwdriver, or similar.





Four mounting holes M6 Screw


WALL MOUNTING

- The TV is provided with mounting holes for a VESA approved wall mounting bracket (not supplied).
- The VESA mounting pattern is:
 200x100mm and the size of the bolts is 4 x M6 x 10 (not supplied).
- Do not use bolts longer than the size specified above for your model or damage will occur
 to the internal components.

NOTES:

- Do not install this product until this manual has been read and understood thoroughly.
 Please keep these instructions for future reference.
- Due to the heavy weight and dimensions of the LCD screens and their fragile nature, we
 recommend that they are unpacked and assembled by 2 people and professional installers
 are used to wall mount them (Wall mounting is optional). If you do not understand the
 instructions, or are unsure how to install this product, please contact a professional for
 assembly advice and assistance.
- Careful consideration should be made regarding the location the television is to be wall
 mounted as some walls are not suitable for installation. If the television is to be mounted on
 drywall, the mount must be anchored into a wooden stud, concrete block or brick behind
 the drywall. Installing on drywall alone will not support the weight of the display.
- When drilling holes, it is particularly important to take care of electrical cables, water or gas
 pipes in the wall. Please follow the instructions provided by the wall bracket manufacturer
 and ensure that all fixing screws supplied are used.




REMOTE CONTROL



INSTALLATION OF BATTERIES

- 1 Remove the battery cover from the rear of the remote control.
- 2 Install two AAA 1.5V batteries. (Ensure the correct polarity of the batteries.)
- 3 Replace the battery cover.




Please take out of the batteries from the remote when it is not going to be used for a long period of time.

If the remote control doesn't work properly, please carry out the following checks.

- Check the TV is turned on.
- Check the polarity of the batteries are correct.
- Check the batteries and replace if necessary
- Check the plug is fully inserted and the socket is switched on.
- Check there are no special fluorescent light or neon light which could interfere with remote signals.

INITIAL SETUP



- 1. Connect your TV to the power outlet.
- 2. Connect your aerial and/or set top box to the television.
- 3. Press the POWER button on the remote to turn on the TV. CAUTION: Always disconnect the TV from the power outlet when the TV will not be used for a long period of time. The POWER button on the television and remote is only used for switching the TV into standby and does not disconnect the device from the mains voltage. To completely disconnect the mains voltage, please remove the plug from the socket.
- 4. Use the $\nabla/\Delta/\blacktriangleleft$ \rightarrow buttons on the remote to follow the setup guide on screen.

FIRST TIME SETUP

Press the **INPUT** button to display the input source list.

Press the ▼ / ▲ or **OK** button to select the input source

Press the **OK** button to select the input source,

Press the **EXIT** button to quit.





Select OSD Language

Use the ▼ / ▲ / ◀ / ▶ buttons to highlight the OSD Language.

Press the **ENTER** button to select the OSD Language you want to.

Select Country

Use the ▼ / ▲ / ◀ / ▶ buttons to highlight your Country.

Press the **ENTER** button to select the Country







Auto Tuning

The DTV tuning can be skipped by pressing the Menu button then the left arrow button.





Signal Information

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select **Signal Information**, press the **Enter** button to see detailed information about the signal. Only available when there is a DTV signal.

PICTURE MENU

Press the **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select **PICTURE** in the main menu.



- Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select the option that you want to adjust in the PICTURE menu.
- 2. Press **OK** button to adjust.
- 3. After finishing your adjustment, Press the **MENU** button to save and return to the previous menu.

Picture Mode

Use the **▼**/ **△**button to select Picture Mode, then press the **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

You can change the value of contrast, brightness, colour, sharpness and tint when the picture is in **Personal** mode.

TIP: You can press the PMODE button to change the Picture Mode directly.



Contrast/ Brightness/ Colour/ Tint / Sharpness

Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select an option, then use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to adjust.

Contrast	Adjust the highlight intensity of the picture, but the shadow of the picture is unchanged.	
Brightness	Adjust the optical output of the entire picture, it will affect the dark region of the picture.	
Colour	Adjust the saturation of the colour based on your preference.	
Tint	Use a compensating colour changed with the transmission in the NTSC code.	
Sharpness	Adjust the detail of the picture.	

Colour Temperature

Change the overall colour cast of the picture.

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select Colour Temperature, then press **OK** to enter the sub-menu.


Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select between Cool, Normal and Warm.

You can change the red, green and blue values when the colour temperature is set to **User** mode.

Cold: Increase the blue tone for the white.

Normal: Increase the linked colours for the white.

Warm: Increase the red colour for the white.



Noise Reduction




To filter out and reduce the image noise and improve the picture quality.

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select Noise Reduction, then press **OK** to enter the sub-menu.

SOUND MENU

Press the **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select **SOUND** in the main menu.



- Use the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select the option that you want to adjust in the SOUND menu.
- 2. Press the **Enter** button to adjust.
- After finishing your adjustment, Press Enter button to save and return to the previous menu.

SOUND MODE

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select Sound Mode, then press **Enter** to enter the sub-menu.

Use the **▼∆**button to select.

You can adjust the Treble and Bass when the sound is in Personal mode.

TIP: You can press **SMODE** button on the remote control to change the Sound Mode.

Standard: Produces a balanced sound in all environments.

Music: Preserves the original sound. Good for musical programs.

Movie: Enhances treble and bass for a rich sound experience.

Sports: Enhances vocals for sports.

Personal: Select to customize picture settings.


NOTE: The treble and bass are only available in **User** mode, you can adjust them as you like.

The Balance, Auto Volume level, surround sound, Digital audio output and SPDIF audio delay can be selected using the ▼ / ▲ button to select option, Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

NOTE:

Balance: Adjusts the speaker's output between the speakers, it enables you to listen to best at your position.

Auto Volume: Used for reducing the difference between channel and program's volume automatically.



TIME MENU

Press the **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select **TIME** in the main menu.



SETUP MENU

Press the **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select **SETUP** in the main menu.



- Use the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select the option that you want to adjust in the SETUP menu.
- 2. Press the **Enter** button to adjust.
- After finishing your adjustment, Press Enter button to save and return to the previous menu.

OSD Language

Select the OSD menu language to be displayed. The default is English.

Use the **▼**/ **△**/ **<** / **▶** buttons to select Menu Language.



PVR File System

Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select PVR File System, then press **Enter** to enter the sub-menu.

Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select Check PVR File System, then press **Enter** to enter.

It will then check the speed of the USB.



Aspect Ratio

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select Aspect Ratio, then press the **Enter** button to enter sub-menu.

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select aspect ratio between Auto, 4:3,16:9, Zoom1 and Zoom2.

Blue Screen (When no input signal)

Use the V/ ▲button to select Blue Screen, then press Enter button to turn On or Off.

First Time Installation

Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select First time installation, then press **Enter** to enter.

Caption

Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select Caption, then press **Enter** to turn on or off.

Software Update (USB)

Adjust the vertical position of the picture.

Use the ▼/ ▲buttons to select **Vertical Pos**, then press **Enter** to the enter sub-menu.

Size

Adjust the display size.

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select **Size**, then press **Enter** to enter the sub-menu.

Phase

Adjust the horizontal interfering lines.

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select **Phase**, then press **Enter** to enter the sub-menu.

Position Reset

Use the **▼**/ **△**buttons to select **Position Reset**, then press **Enter** to enter.

MEDIA MENU


To enter the **Media** menu, a USB device should be inserted, and the INPUT button used to set the Input Source to **Media**



Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select the option you want to view in the **Media** menu, then press **Enter** to enter.

Photo

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select PHOTO in the main menu, then press **Enter** to enter. Press the **Exit** button to return to the previous menu and exit menu to quit.



Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select the file you want to watch within the **menu**, then press the media button to display the picture. When highlighting the option, the file information will appear on the right and picture will be previewed in the centre.

Music Menu

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select MUSIC in the main menu, then press **Enter** to enter. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu and exit menu to quit.



Use the \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright buttons to select the drive you want to watch, then press **Enter** to enter.

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to return to the previous menu.






Movie Menu

Use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to select MOVIE in the main menu, then press **Enter** button to enter. Press **Exit** button to return to the previous menu and exit menu to quit.

Press display to select the menu at the bottom you want to run, then press **Enter** button to operate.



Press **Exit** to go back to the previous menu and the exit button again to quit the entire menu.


Text Menu

DVD

The DVD settings menu is operated using arrows on the remote control. Use the ▼ / ▲ buttons to select an item within the menu and the ◀ / ▶ buttons to adjust it.

General Settings Page



TV Display

Some DVD discs have been authored in 4:3 aspect ratio format. To see the material in its original mode, you may need to change the Aspect ratio.

Pan & Scan (4: 3) Black edges left and right will be seen.

Letterbox (4: 3) Top and bottom of the screen may be black.

Wide 16:9 (Widescreen) Full width picture but may have black areas top and bottom.

OSD Language. Select the OSD Language (English is default).

Last Memory. ON/OFF. You may wish the player to remember where it finished playing a disc and then remove the disc. When you stop the disc, the player will automatically remember the point it finished playing. When the disc is re inserted the player will continue from the same point.

Audio Setup

When the DVD menu is displayed, the DVD system will auto pause. Press SETUP again, it will go on.

Press the SETUP button on remote control during playing DVD, Press the ◀ / ▶ buttons the following menu is shown.

Press the ▼ / ▲ buttons to choose the option, then enter the desired option using the OK button. It has been set when the desired item becomes red.

Note: Press the Left button to return to the previous menu.


Press SETUP to exit the menu.

Dolby Setup



Dynamic is the difference between the maximum level and the minimum level of sound. This function is generally used when playing high volume programs at night, in order not to disturb the neighbour. This setting can lower the volume while keeping the original tone quality. This is the range, measured in decibels(dB), between the loudest and the quietest sound registered in a soundtrack.

Video Setup



Sharpness: Adjust the sharpness of the image.

Brightness: Select 'Brightness' by using the ▼ / ▲ buttons, then press OK. You can adjust the


Brightness by using the ◀ / ▶ buttons. To exit the 'Brightness' setting, press OK again.

Contrast: Select 'Contrast' by using the ▼ / ▲ buttons, then press OK to select.

You can adjust the Contrast using the ◀ / ▶ buttons.

To exit 'Contrast' To exit the 'Brightness' setting, press OK again.

Preference Setup



TV Type

Select between PAL. AUTO or NTSC.

Audio

Select the preferred language for DVD audio.

- 1. The selected language is assigned high priority and can therefore be adopted automatically when the player begins playing a disc.
- 2. Languages vary between discs, depending on the DVD. You can also select alternative languages by pressing the AUDIO button on the remote

Subtitle

Selects the preferred language for subtitles recorded on Discs.

- 1. The selected subtitle language is assigned high priority and can therefore be adopted automatically when the player begins playing a disc.
- 2. Subtitles vary between discs, depending on the Discs. You can also select alternative subtitle language by pressing the SUBTITLE button on the remote.

Disc Menu

Select the preferred language for the disc menu recorded on the Discs. This choice varies between Discs.

Parental

It is possible to restrict playback of certain Discs to a certain level of user, based on their age, for example. Certain scenes can be blocked or replaced with different scenes. The "Parental Control" function lets you set the access control level. This function is password-protected.

Note: If you play discs that do not support the Parental Control function, the DVD player cannot restrict access to the disc.

Change the password. The default password is 0000.

Restore the DVD player's system to factory default settings.
